**SUBJECT:** Application of clause 6-3.04 and article 6-5.00 of the S11 collective agreement (2010-2015) to update the hourly salary scales and rates, premiums and supplements

The purpose of this letter of agreement is to update the hourly salary scales and rates as well as the premiums and supplements applicable to support staff of English-language school boards as a result of the increase prescribed in the clause relating to the gross domestic product (clause 6-3.04 and article 6-5.00) of the S11 collective agreement (2010-2015).

The 1% granted on April 1, 2012 is thus increased to 1.5% and is retroactive to that same date.

It should be noted that only the modified premiums are found in this letter of agreement.

Consequently, clauses 6-5.02, 6-5.03 a) and c), 6-5.05, 6-6.06, 6-8.02 and Appendix I are modified as follows and the following tables replace those of the consolidated S11 collective agreement (2010-2015) found on the CPNCA Website:

#### 6-5.02 Day care service split shift premium

An employee who must interrupt his or her work for a period exceeding the time scheduled for his or her meal or more than once a day shall receive a premium for each day thus worked, based on the rate in effect:
