The purpose of this letter of agreement is to update the hourly salary scales and rates as well as the premiums and supplements applicable to support staff of English-language school boards as a result of the increase prescribed in the clause relating to the gross domestic product (clauses 6-3.05 and 6-4.01) of the S12 collective agreement (2010-2015).

The 1% granted on April 1, 2012 is thus increased to 1.5% and is retroactive to that same date.

It should be noted that only the modified premiums are found in this letter of agreement.

Consequently, clauses 6-4.02 B) a), C) and D), 6-4.04, 6-7.11, 6-8.02, 6-9.01 A) and B) as well as Appendix 1 are modified as follows and the following tables replace those of the consolidated S12 collective agreement (2010-2015) found on the CPNCA Website:

B) Premium for Additional Responsibility
