**SUBJECT:** Application of clauses 6-3.04 and 6-6.01 of the S18 collective agreement (2010-2015) to update the hourly salary scales and rates, premiums and supplements

The purpose of this letter of agreement is to update the hourly salary scales and rates as well as the premiums and supplements applicable to support staff of English-language school boards as a result of the increase prescribed in the clause relating to the gross domestic product (clauses 6-3.04 and 6-6.01) of the S18 collective agreement (2010-2015).

The 1% granted on April 1, 2012 is thus increased to 1.5% and is retroactive to that same date.

It should be noted that only the modified premiums are found in this letter of agreement.

Consequently, clauses 6-6.04 a), c) and d), 6-6.05, 6-6.07, 6-7.01 a) and b) as well as Appendix 1 are modified as follows and the following tables replace those of the consolidated S18 collective agreement (2010-2015) found on the CPNCA Website:

#### 6-6.04 Premium for Additional Responsibility

a) The stationary engineer who principally and customarily supervises the installation of a combination of boilers and refrigeration equipment located in the same area and who possesses the two (2) required certificates, the heating/steam engine certificate and the refrigeration equipment certificate, shall receive, in addition to the salary rate prescribed for his or her class of employment, a salary supplement according to the rate in effect:

#### 6-6.05 Split Shift Premium in a Day Care Service

When two (2) buildings of the same institutional school or centre are located more than one kilometre from one another, they shall be considered, for the purpose of this clause only, as two (2) distinct institutional schools or centres.

#### 6-7.01

When the board decides to entrust the loan and rental of rooms to its employees, the duties described hereinafter shall be offered, according to seniority, to employees in the classes of employment of caretaker or maintenance workman, class II or III in the school or centre. The board and the union may agree on a different distribution.

The employee who is requested by the board to look after the loan and rental of rooms outside his or her regular working hours shall be paid according to the following provisions:

a) For the opening of the school or centre and of the rooms used, supervision during the activity and the closing of the school or centre and the rooms used<sup>1</sup>:
